What specific challenges do these coastal communities face in developing effective policies to adapt to climate change?

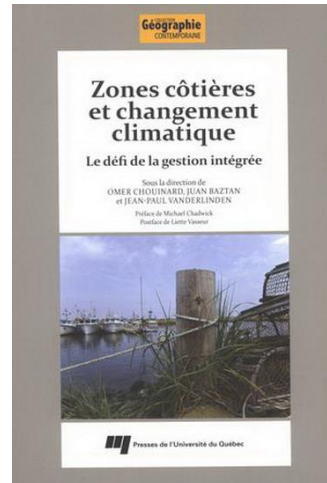
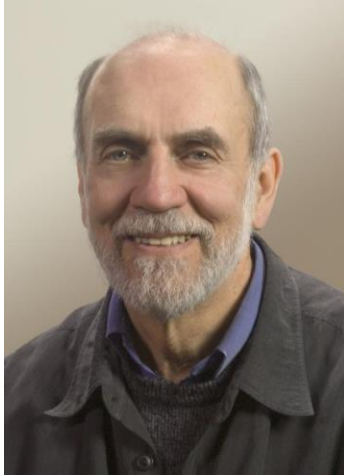
How can we, as researchers, contribute and work together with these communities in order to develop effective strategies that are also rooted in Acadian cultural meaning and historical experience?

Results: culturally mediated strategies and policies to address the specific challenges of the CGD region, research publications, contribution to ARTISTICCC



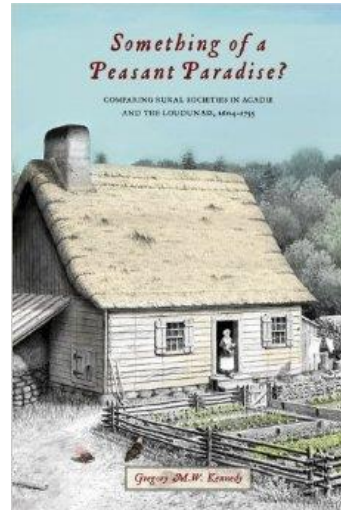
