- FOCUS ON OUR ROLE – this article is about our stories as natural scientist working in communities and interdisciplinary teams

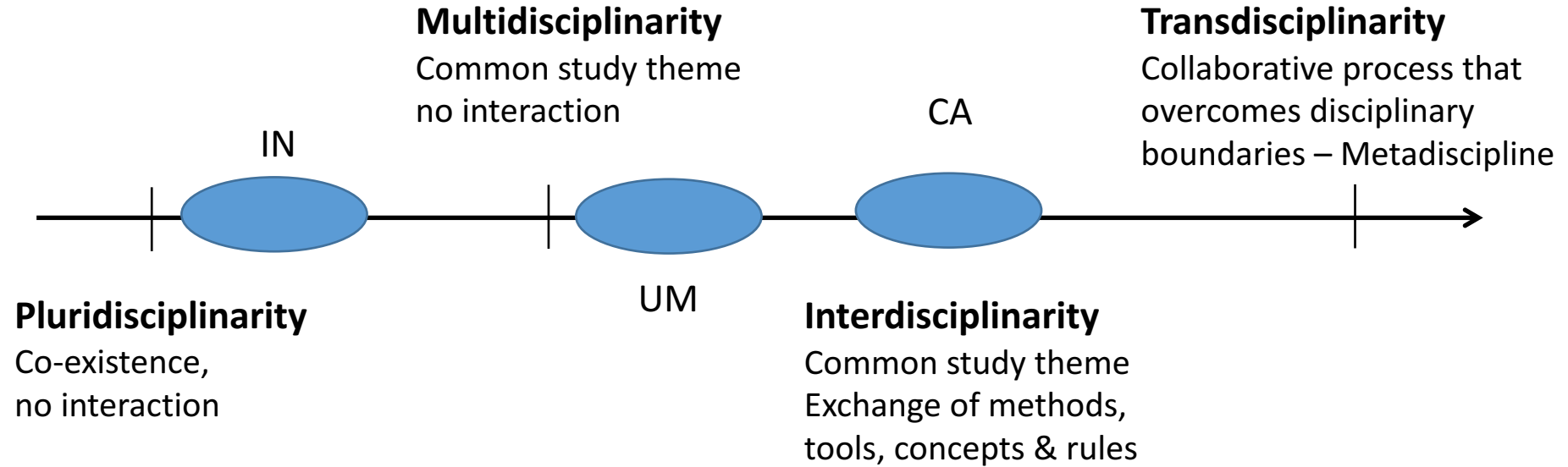
Objective of this session

 - Level of enabling use of natural sciences

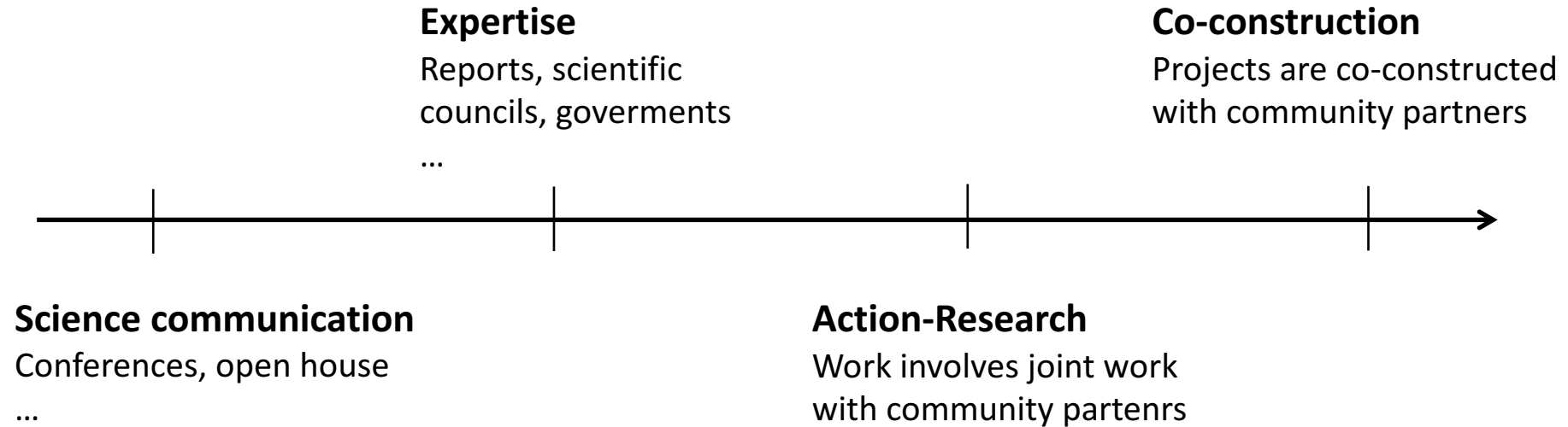
Objective of this session
